William Wilberforce convinced his generation that slavery was a sin which led to abolition in the 19th Century. In the 21st Century that mindset hasn't changed, and yet cases of modern-day slavery are on the rise in Britain. 45.8 million people are estimated to be trapped in some form of modern slavery in the world today: more than 13,000 victims in the UK.

Modern slavery is an umbrella term for all forms of slavery, trafficking and exploitation. At the core of this crime is deception, oppression and fear: the threat of violence to the victims or their families hangs over them and traps the slaves in their situation: it's an appalling crime against humanity. We believe that the tools to end modern slavery already exist within the local community and that the Church, which is present in all communities and at the heart of many, has a primary responsibility in leading these efforts.
