





## Unstoppable: Living the Acts1:8 life

### A New Sermon Series on the Book of Acts

#### Week 2 – Peter's first Sermon

The Holy Spirit is the true "Engine of Mission," empowering believers to cross cultural, social, and geographic boundaries that once seemed impassable.

In Acts 2, Peter's first sermon provides a timeless blueprint for sharing our faith. What can we learn?

**Be Christ-Centred:** Peter focused entirely on Jesus' life, death, and resurrection, not his own opinions. Share both your experiences of Jesus in your life and the historic facts of Jesus' life.

**Be Spirit-Led:** Boldness comes from the Holy Spirit, not personal confidence. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you.

**Be Relatable:** Peter used familiar scriptures to meet the crowd where they were. What common ground could you share with others that could lead to a conversation about God?

**Be Direct:** He called for a response, inviting people to repent and believe. How can we pray for family and friends to be responsive to the good news of Jesus? If they ask, how can you lead them to Jesus?

Who can you share Jesus with this week? When we speak, the Spirit does the "heart-cutting" work, not us. We are simply called to walk in the unforced rhythms of His grace.

Go in peace to love and serve and **share** the Lord.
