God of this City – Reflection on Acts 17

Walking the streets of Athens, Paul was deeply disturbed—not by hostility, but by misplaced devotion. Surrounded by idols, he chose neither withdrawal nor condemnation. Instead, he listened, learned, and built bridges, speaking about Jesus in language people could understand.

That same challenge faces the church today. Our towns may look different, but the idols remain: comfort, consumption, power, distraction. The call of Acts 17 is to be both *distinctive and a blessing*—present in our communities, loving our neighbours, and gently pointing to the living God who gives life and hope.

And remember **Acts 1:8** 'You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses ... to the ends of the earth', even to Chatham. He is the God of this city.
