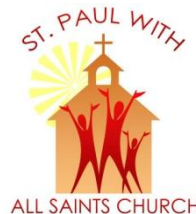

Congregation Survey - key Priorities for 2026/7

Our PCC met on 13th July and considered the congregational survey, produced, analysed and prayerfully reflected on by the Intergenerational Group. Here is the summary of the priorities:

- Continue to invest in growing leaders – through Bishop's certificate, ordination training and youth and children's training
- Urgently consider envisioning an 18-30's group
- Consider developing a youth band with help from external resource
- Develop link with Greenvale School as we continue to reach out to the White Road Estate
- Take forward building improvement plans (new toilets and Solar Panels).
